







A Treasure Hunt





Become a Giver:

- Reciprocity
- 1: the quality or state of being <u>reciprocal</u>: mutual dependence, action, or influence
 - 2: a mutual exchange of privileges

Become a Giver:

Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.

⁷Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

⁸And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.

⁹As it is written: "He has scattered abroad his gifts to the poor; his righteousness endures forever."

Become a Giver:

- Gifts, help other people financially start with family
- Local church, Charities and Relief efforts: local, national, and international organizations (NT gives no minimum or maximum)

²⁷Therefore we are sending Judas and Silas to confirm by word of mouth what we are writing. ²⁸It seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us not to burden you with anything beyond the following requirements: ²⁹You are to abstain from food sacrificed to idols, from blood, from the meat of strangled animals and from sexual immorality. You will do well to avoid these things. Farewell.

¹Now about the collection for God's people: Do what I told the Galatian churches to do. ²On the first day of every week, **each one of you should set aside a sum of money in keeping with his income**, saving it up, so that when I come no collections will have to be made. 1Corinthians 16: 1-2



Local church offerings (median is about 10%)

- 1. Abraham gave 10% of the spoils of war while Israel was required to give less from the spoils of war. (Hebrews 7:4; Numbers 31:28-30)
- 2. Of all the recorded events about giving in the New Testament Church, there is not a single one about tithing.
- 3. Jacob freely offered the tithe because he knew without a requirement, it was of freewill to give. (Genesis 28:20)
- 4. Abraham was born under an Old Testament covenant that was established long before Moses. (Genesis 3; Hebrews 8:13)
- 5. The poor received the tithes and did not pay them. (Deuteronomy 26:12)
- 6. There is no New Testament command to continue or even modify tithing according to the structure of the Old Covenant.
- 7. The tithe came from Israelites who grew food or raised animals. (Leviticus 27:30)
