





Justice

- the practice of what is right or just. It specifies what
 is right, not only according to a law, but also what
 makes for right relationships as well as harmony and
 peace.
- Bible speaks more about <u>doing justice</u> than simply the legal emphasis of the English term. <u>Doing justice</u> is to maintain what is right or to set things right. Justice is done when honorable relationships are maintained.



Justice

- Pray and ask for God's grace to face the past.
- Forgive and release each offense against you.
- Forgive and release each person, not just what they did or said.
- Pray for the family member(s) that hurt and offended you.
- Confess this to someone you trust and make yourself accountable.





Judgment

- primarily denotes "a separating," then a decision, it is discerning and separating between good and evil.
- involves evaluating, appraising, reviewing, and then making a decision.
- based upon a standard, code or law.
